Exception to Policy

Pursing a Second Degree After General Studies, AAS Conferral

Students who have received a General Studies, Associate in Applied Science (GEN) degree may not receive another degree from the college without permission. See Policy 2.10 (https://catalog.dccc.edu/policies-procedures/academic-affairs/2_10/)

Students may petition for an exception if they are returning to the college to pursue a degree significantly different from the coursework applied to their General Studies degree.

To apply for an exception, a student must submit a written request to the Academic Dean of the Division of the proposed second degree. For example, to the Dean of Allied Health and Nursing if interested in a degree in Nursing.

If the student is approved for a second degree, the following restrictions apply:

- Credits from the previous General Studies degree will typically only be applied to the General Education/College Academic Learning Goals (CALG) requirements, not to Major requirements.
- Students may apply a maximum of 30 credits to the new degree.

A student who has previously received a degree from the College may not be re-admitted to receive a General Studies degree.
